1. CONSTRUCTION OF 2 CLASSROOM BLOCKS FOR ST KELVIN SECONDARY SCHOOL

Through the devolution funds, Chipinge Town Council managed to construct 2x3 classroom blocks and ablution facilities. The school is now open with form 1,2 and 3 pupils now accessing education at the site. The school has a total establishment of 183 pupils. Previously, the ward was without a secondary school and the establishment of school has reduced the walking distance for the local pupils and other pupils from peri- urban farms. This has improved access to education for the local students. Council was privileged that the project was carried out with the buy in of the local people as Council got community participation from builders who offered technical support.





7. MANICALAND YOUTH HOUSING SCHEME –REITVLEI

In tandem with NDS1 to address the National priority area of Housing delivery, Council is also carrying out a Manicaland Youth housing scheme project. Ground breaking ceremony was done and MoU signing between Council, Manicaland Youth and the Financier Empowerbank was done. Roads opening and main line water trenching is in progress. Upon completion this will be a flagship project as Chipinge is the first local authority to have such an initiative for the youth. The layout has over 3 600 stands comprising of all facilities. To date 1 200 stands have been title surveyed and more than 500 youths have been allocated the stands and occupation will be done after the stands have been serviced. Roads construction and water reticulation works are currently underway where 7km road opening and grading was done and 2km transmission line has been trenched.
